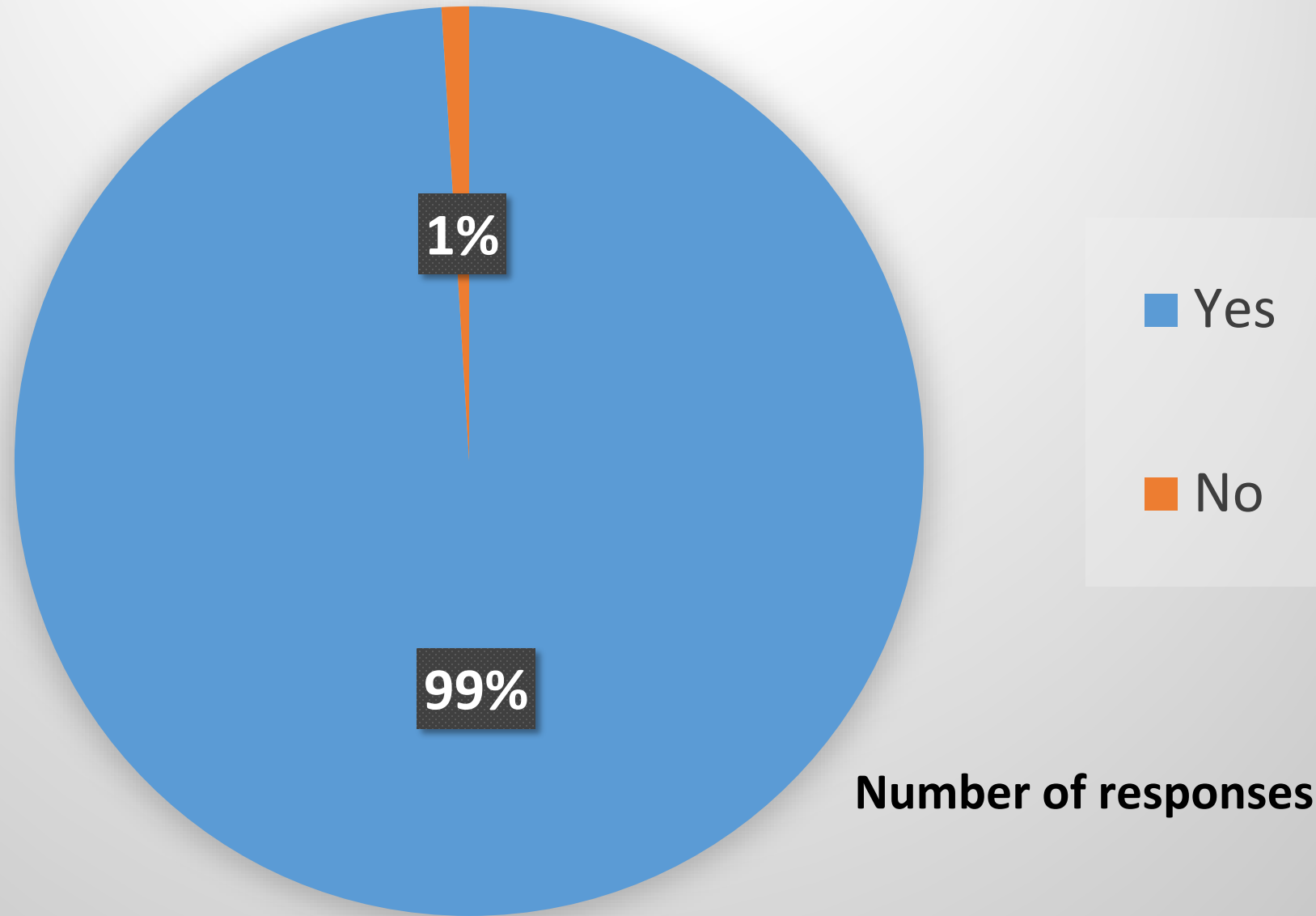

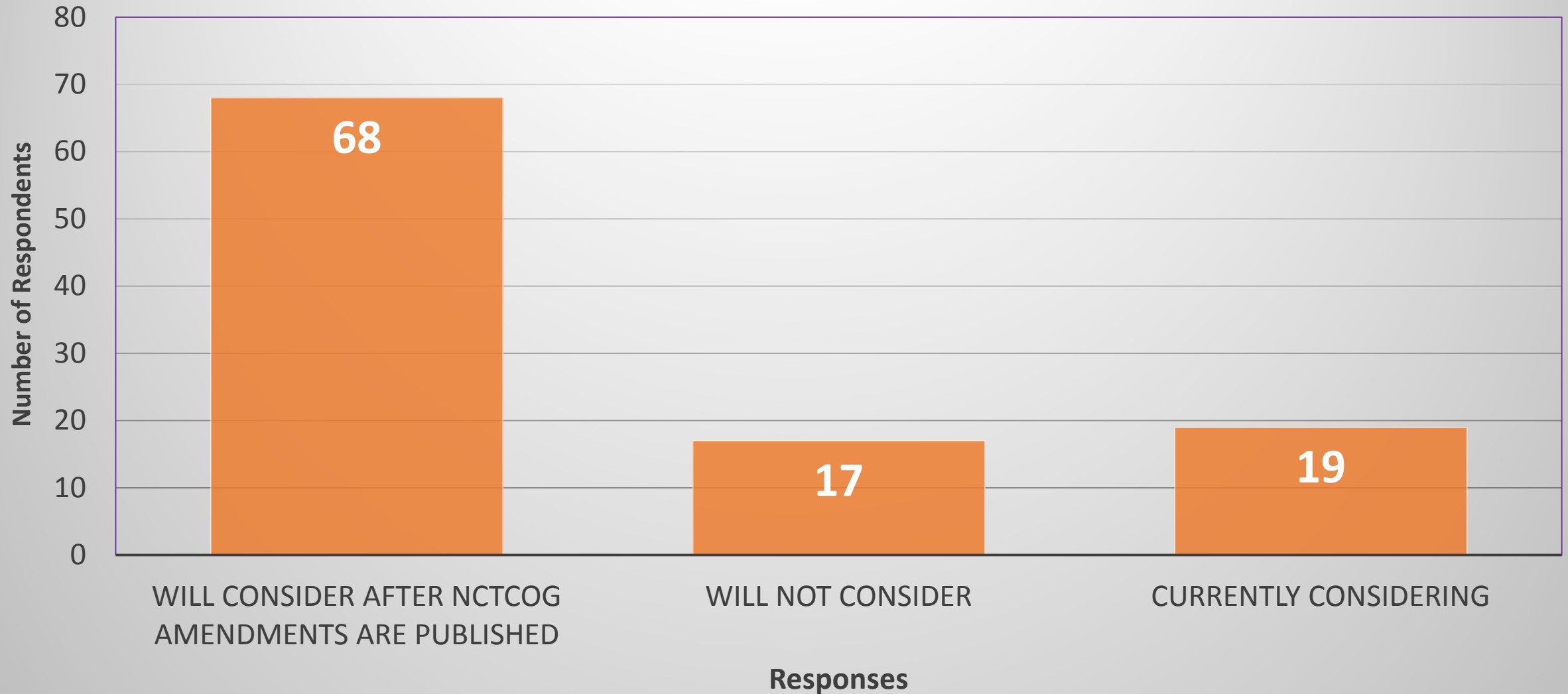

What is your city's code adoption schedule?

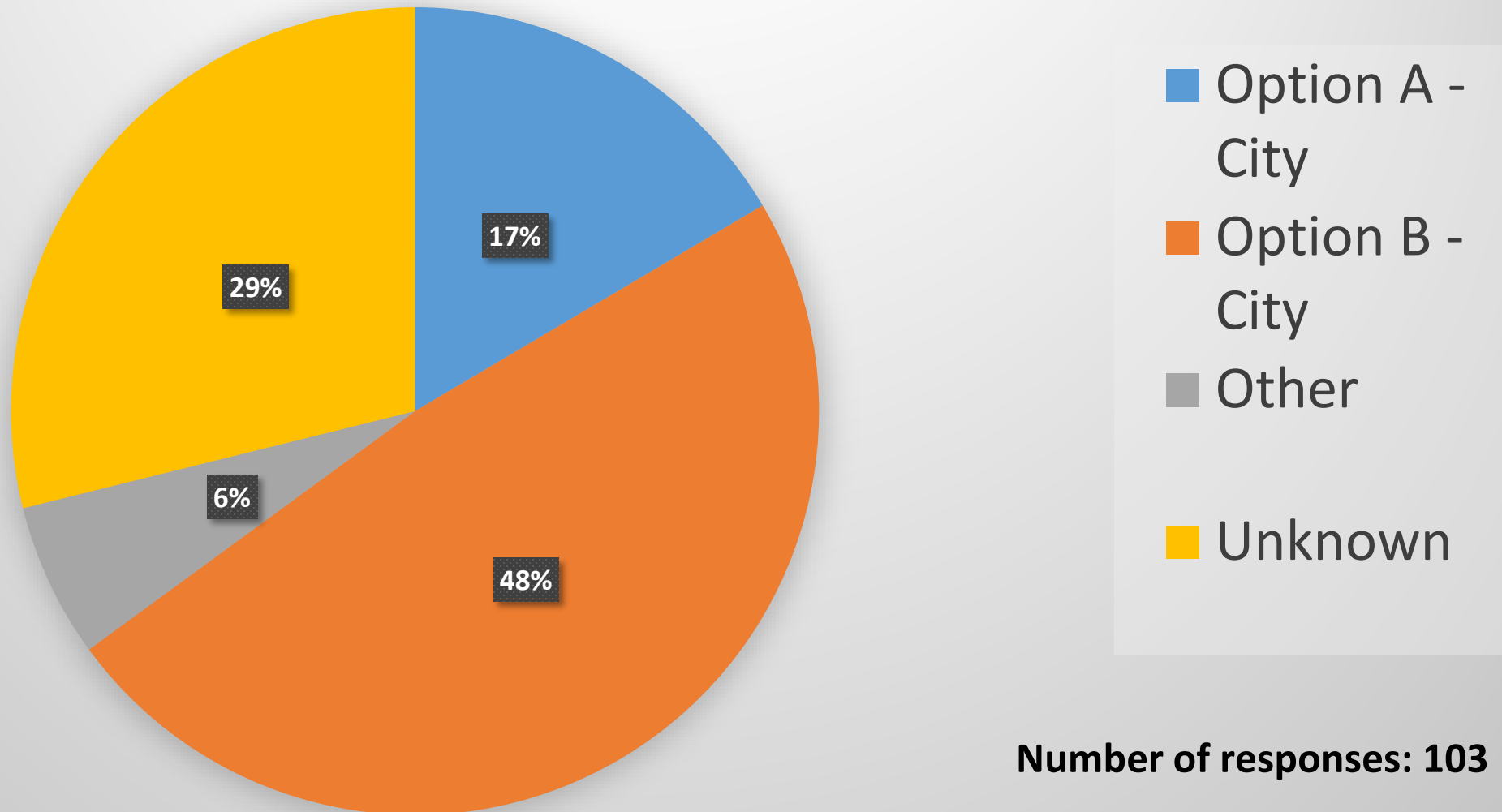


When does your city anticipate adopting the 2015 Codes?

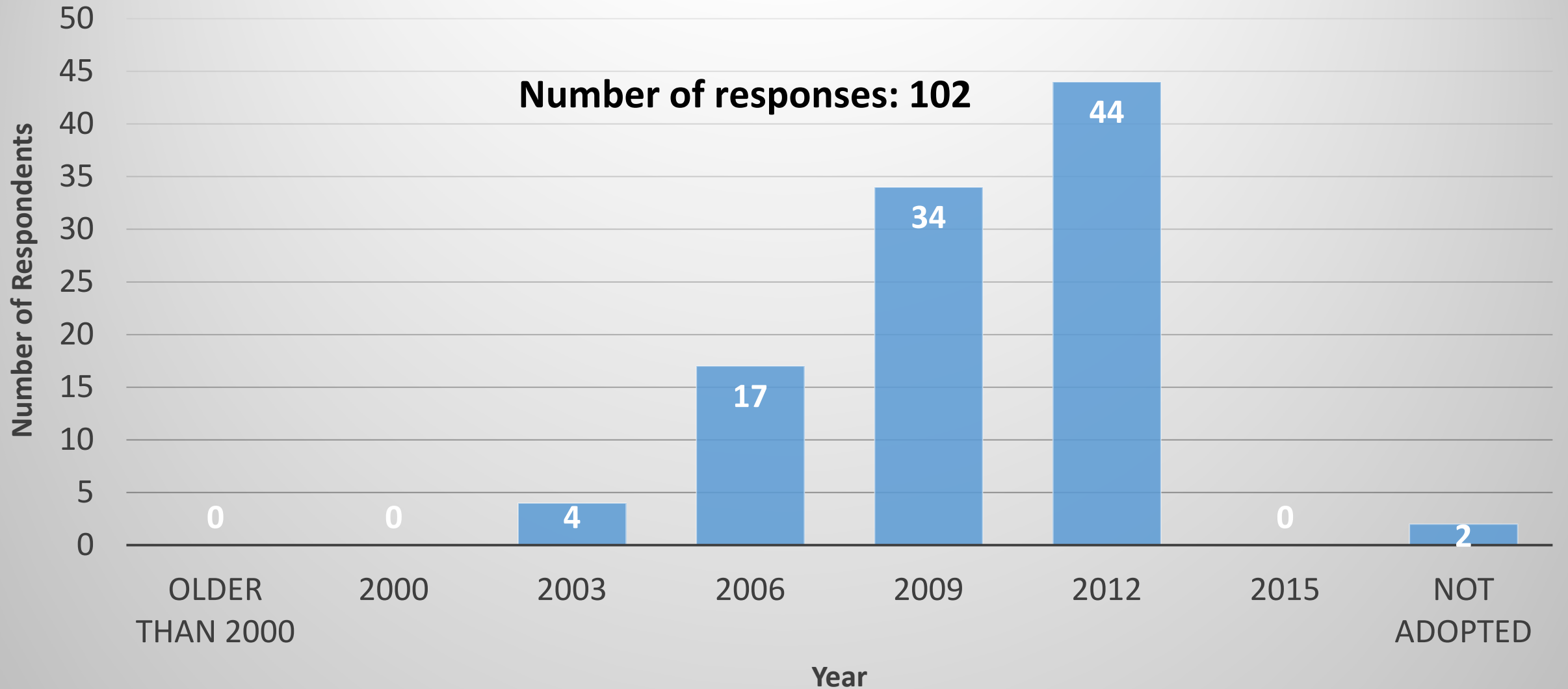


**If adopting the International Building Codes or International Fire Code,
is your city an Option A city or an Option B city?**

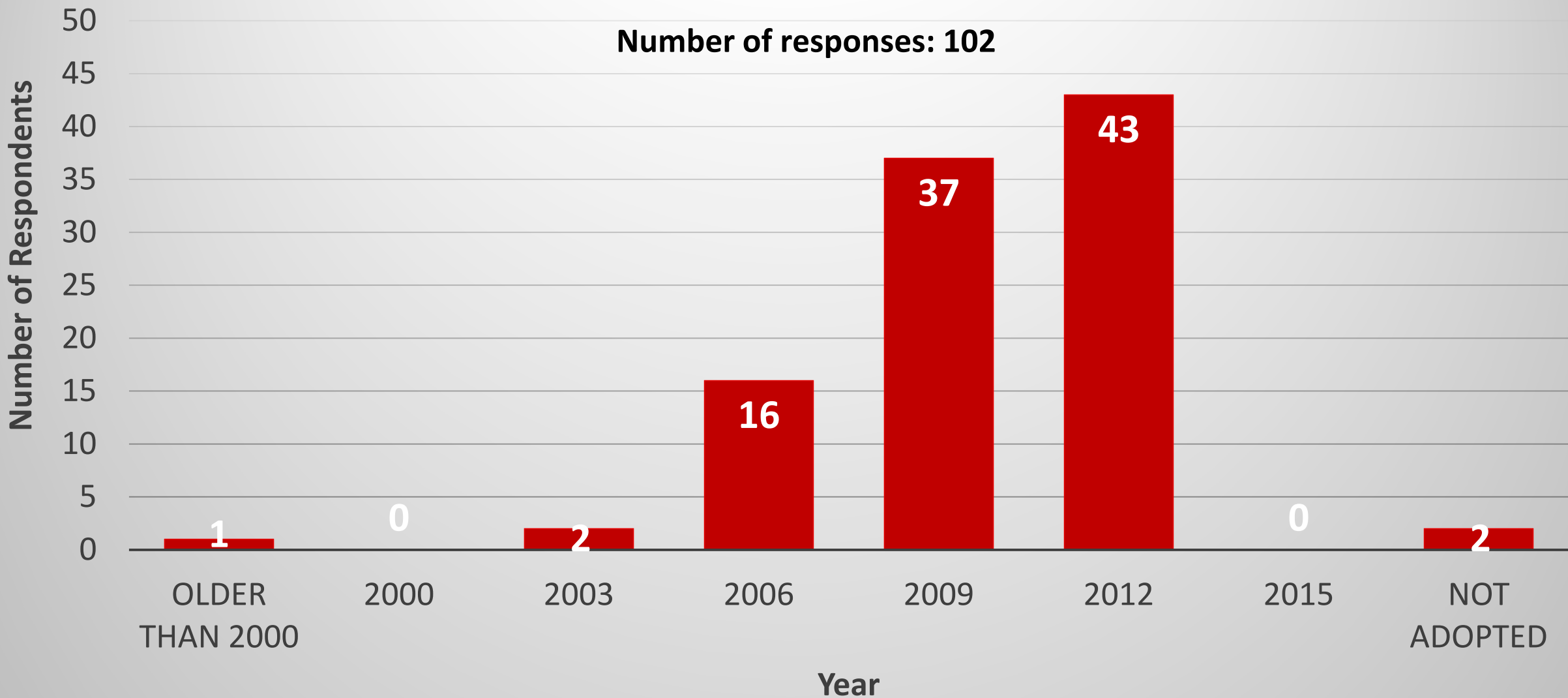

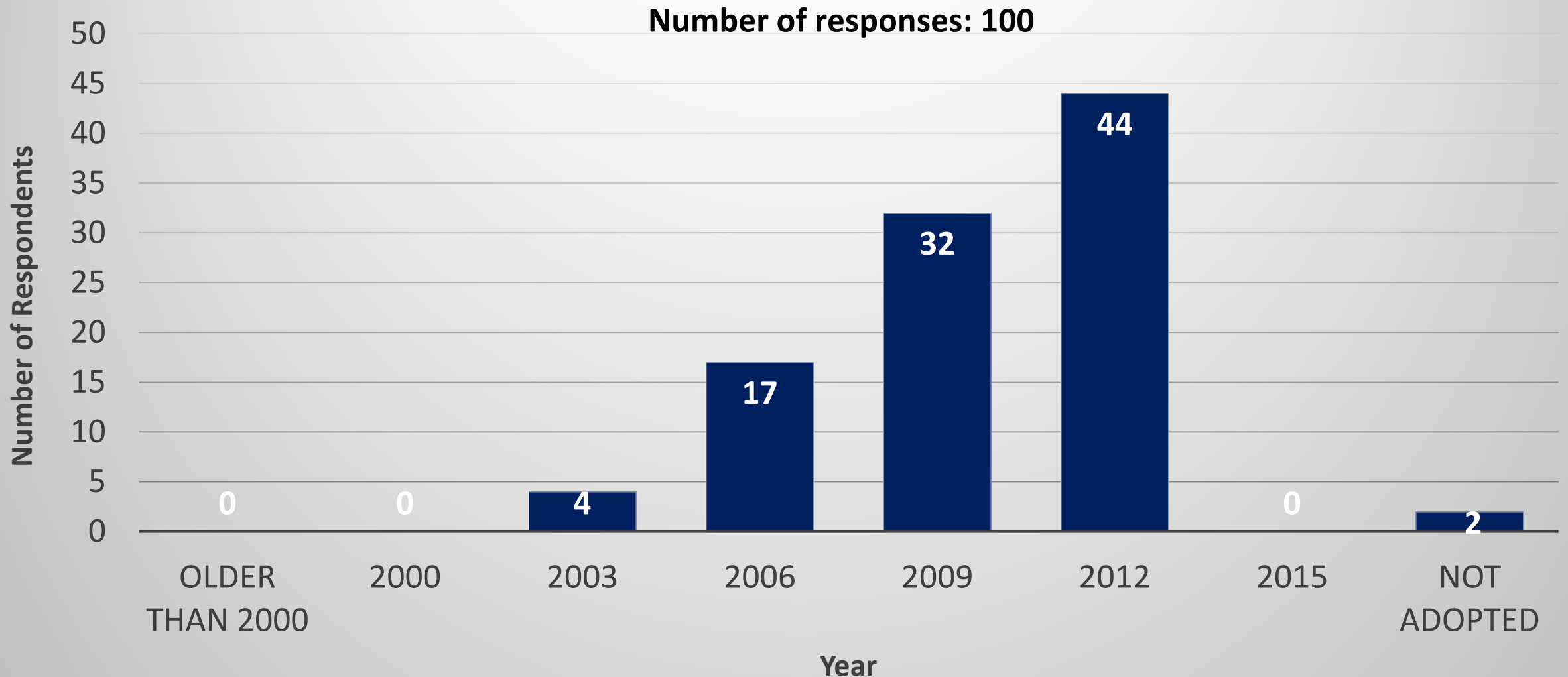

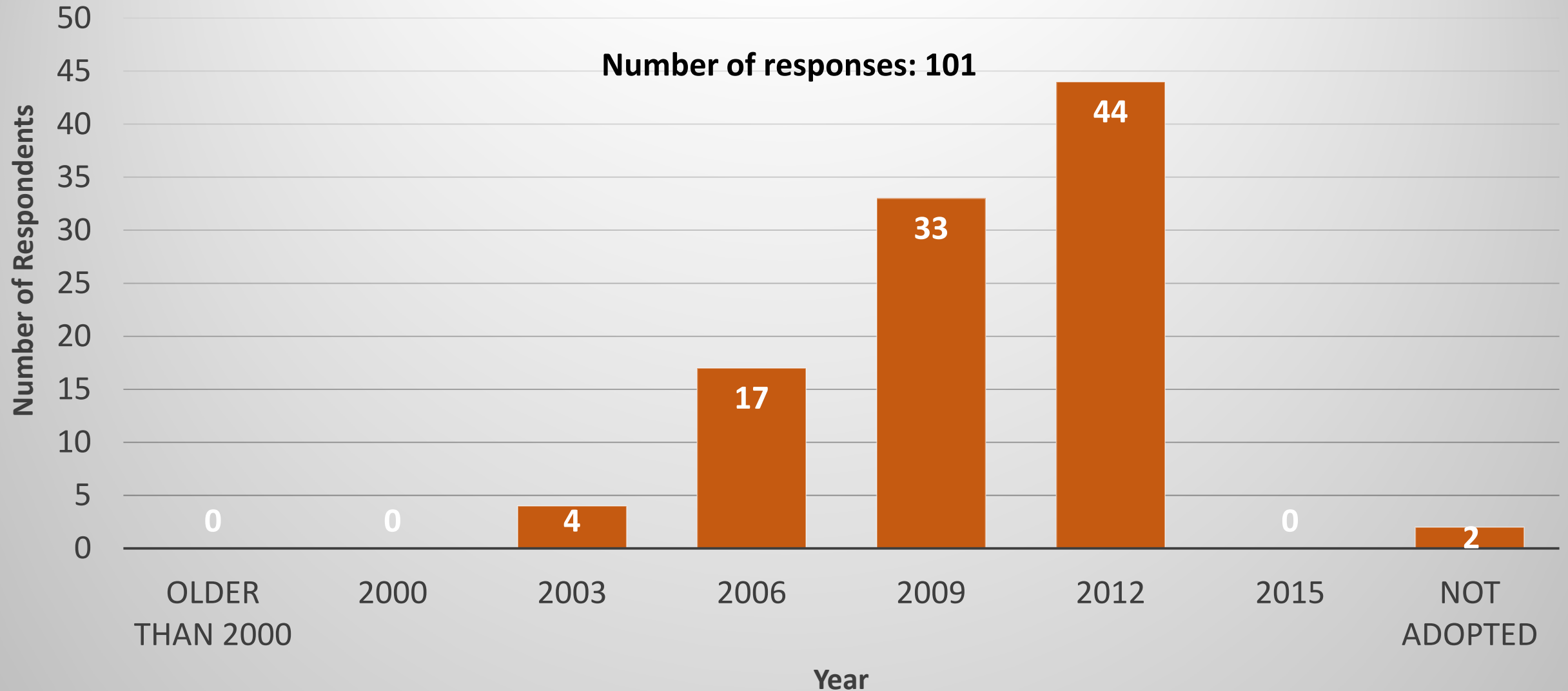
Indicate the year of the code your city has most recently adopted - International Fire Code



Indicate the year the code your city has most recently adopted – International Mechanical Code

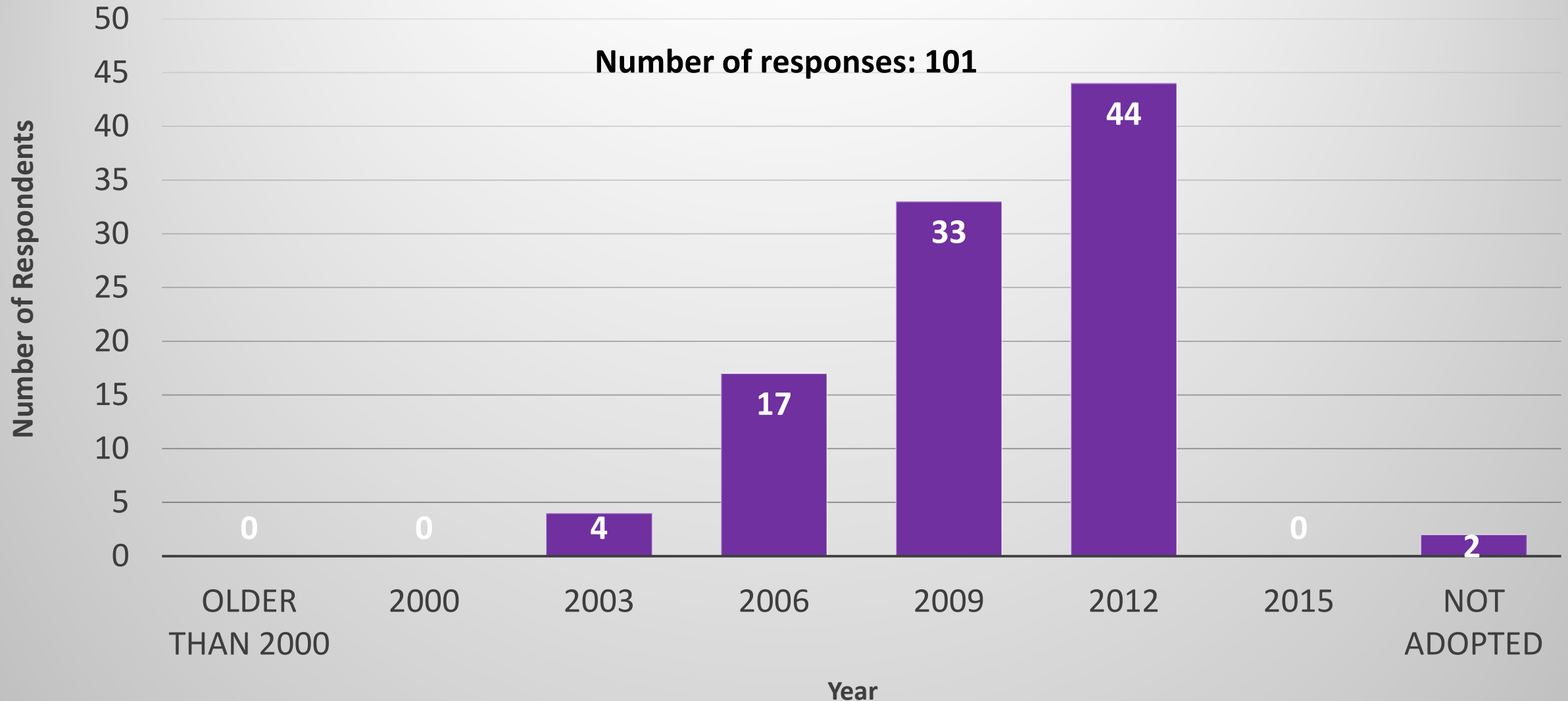


Indicate the year of the code your city has most recently adopted - International Plumbing Code



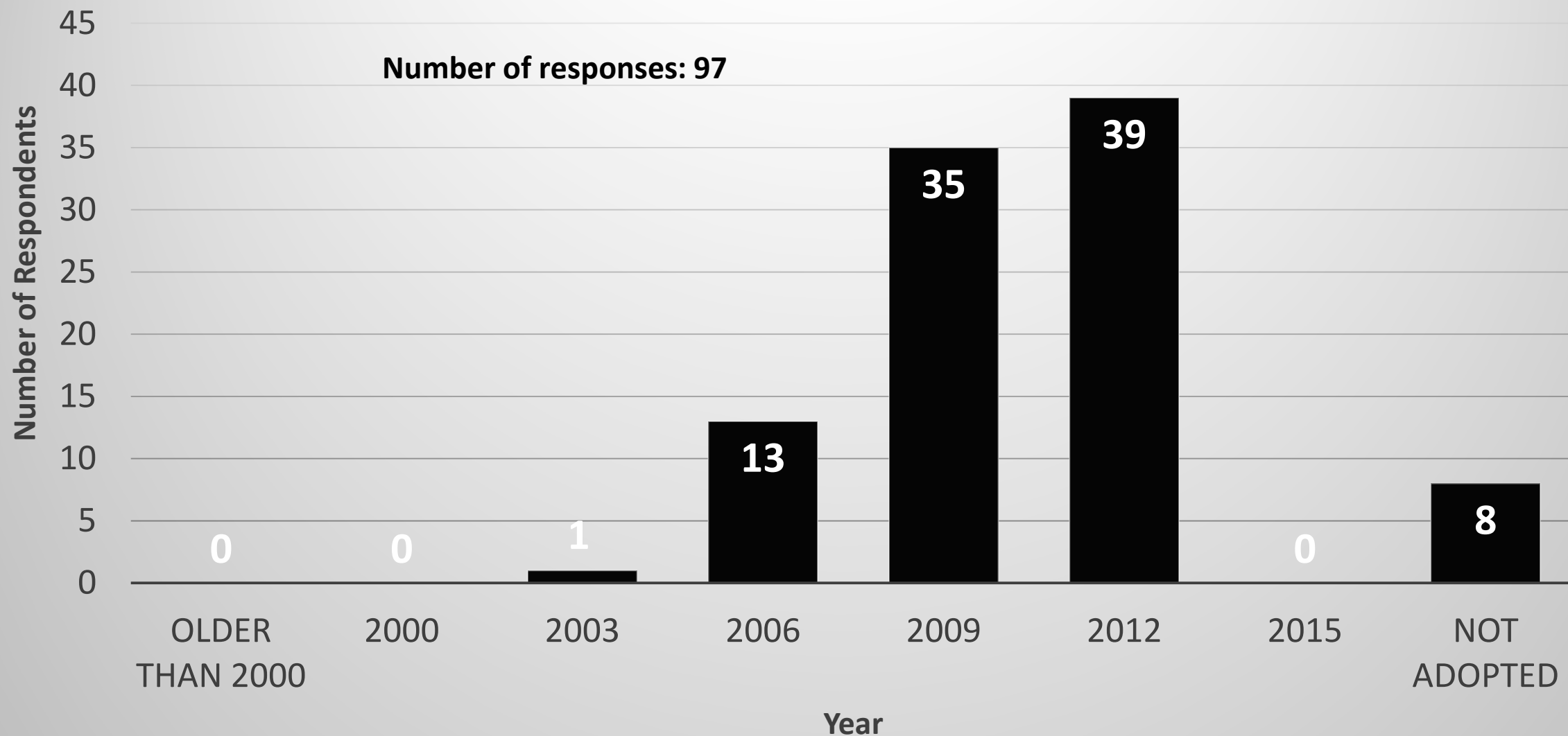

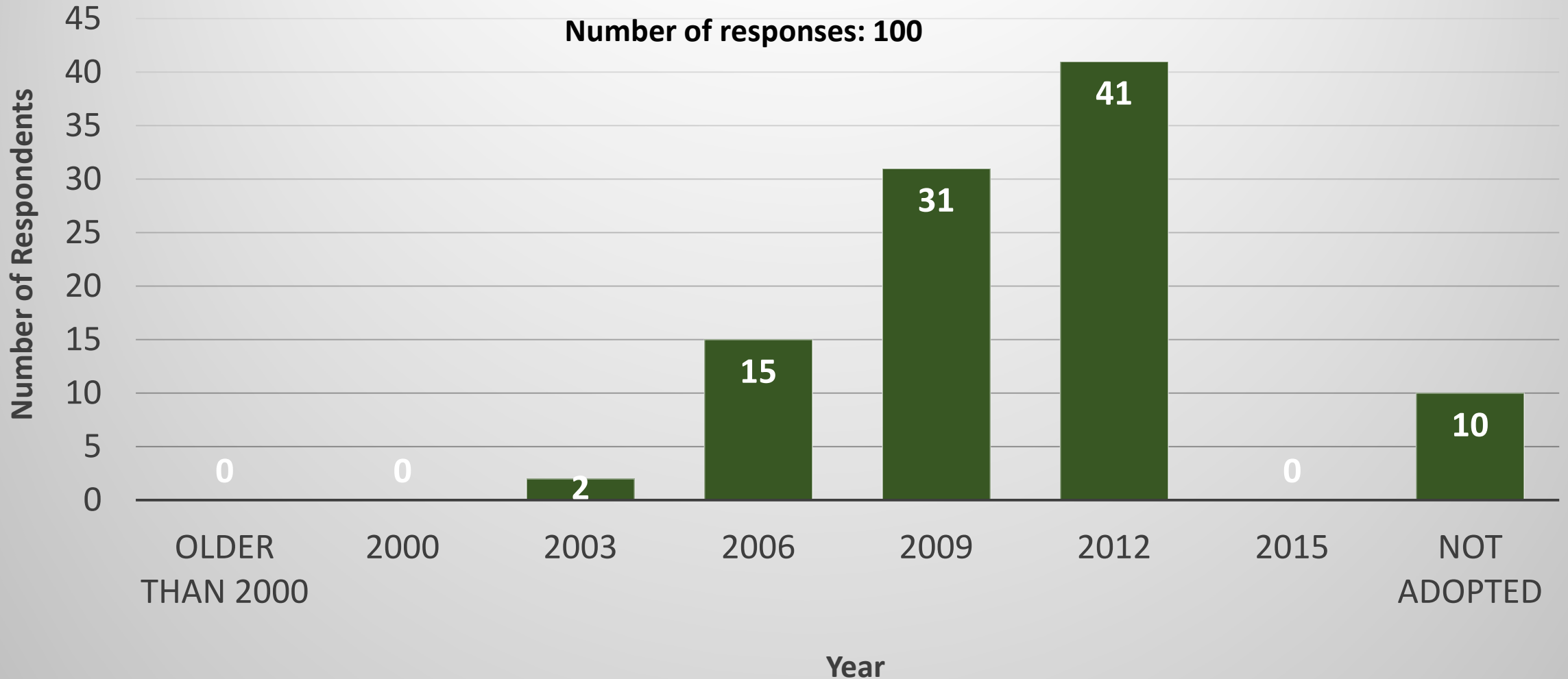

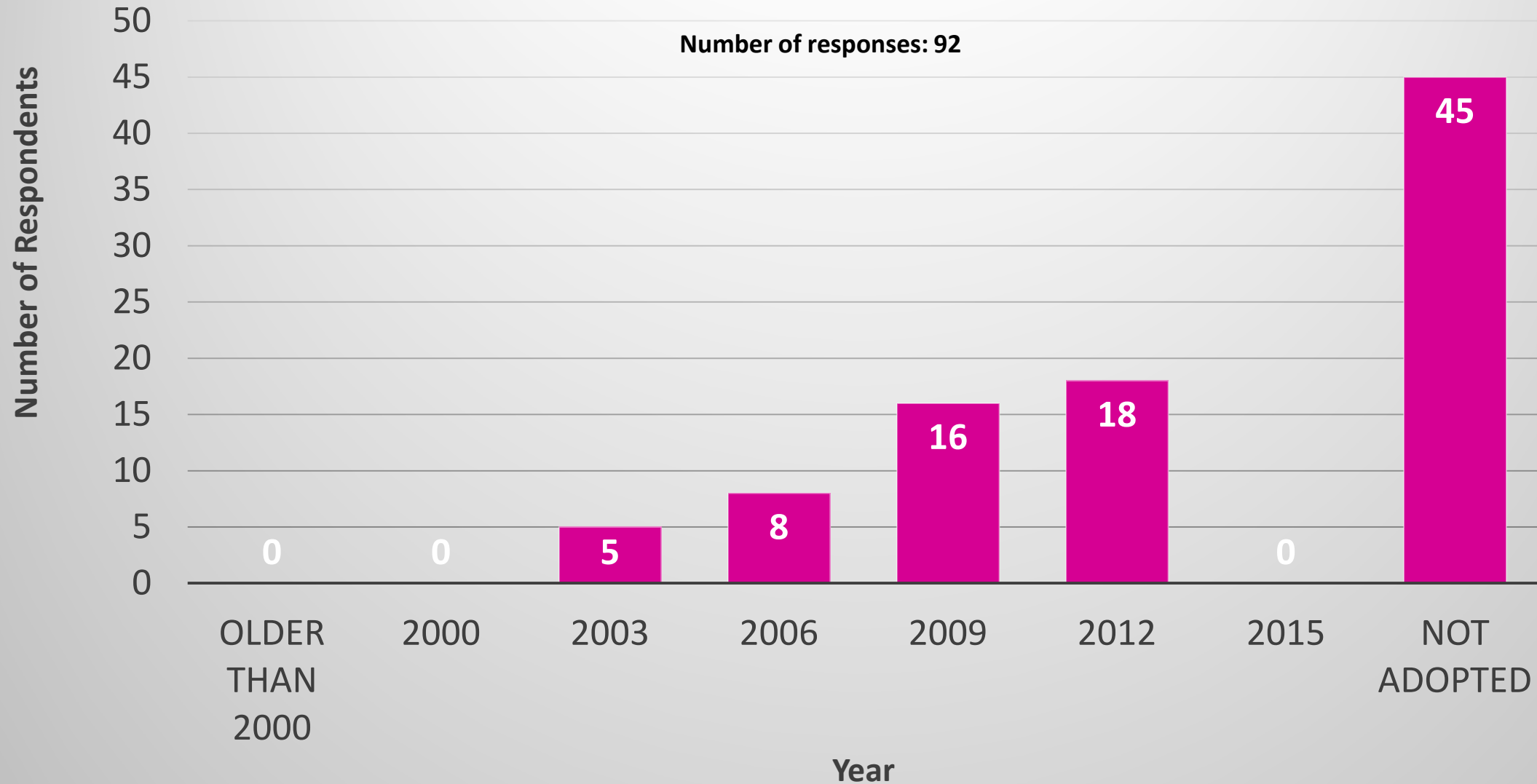

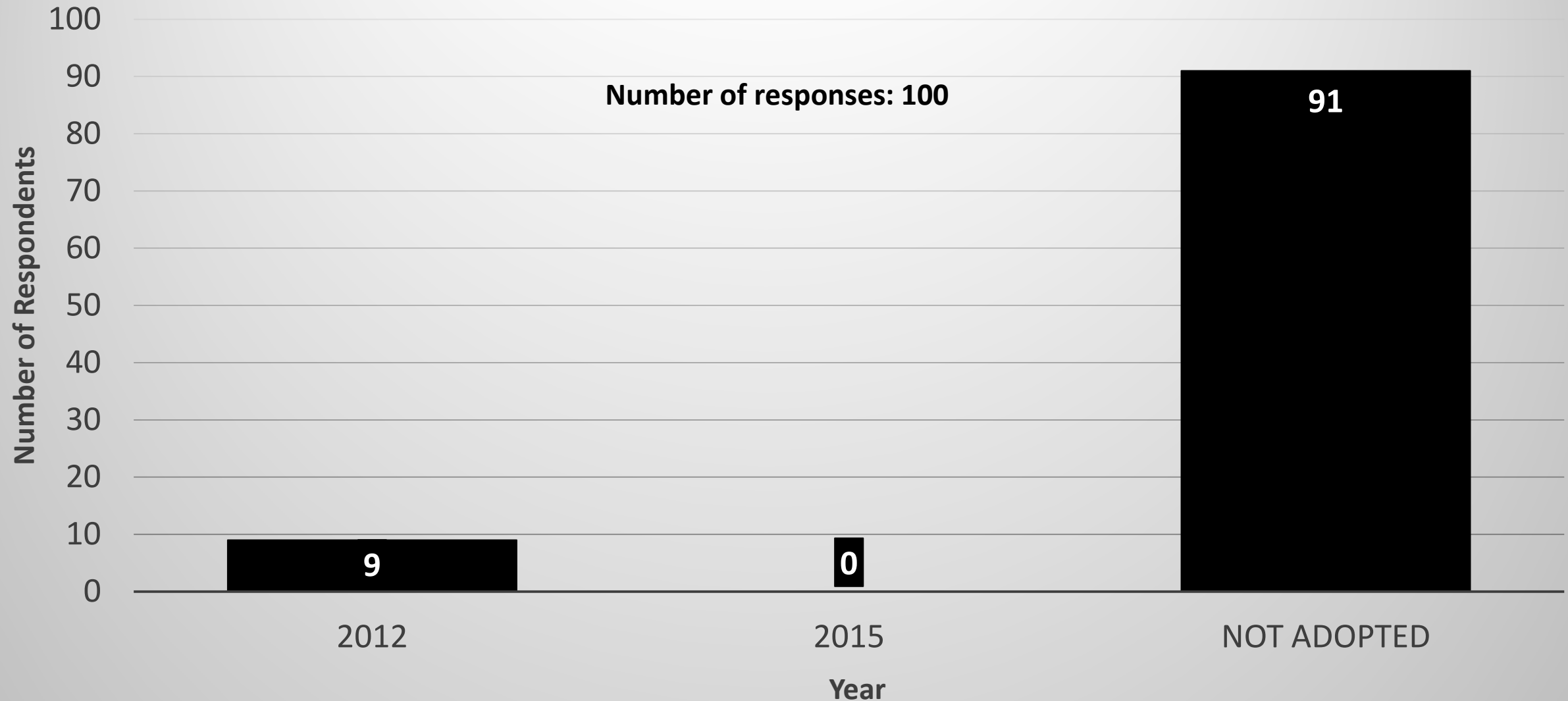
Indicate the year of the code your city has most recently adopted - International Fuel Gas Code

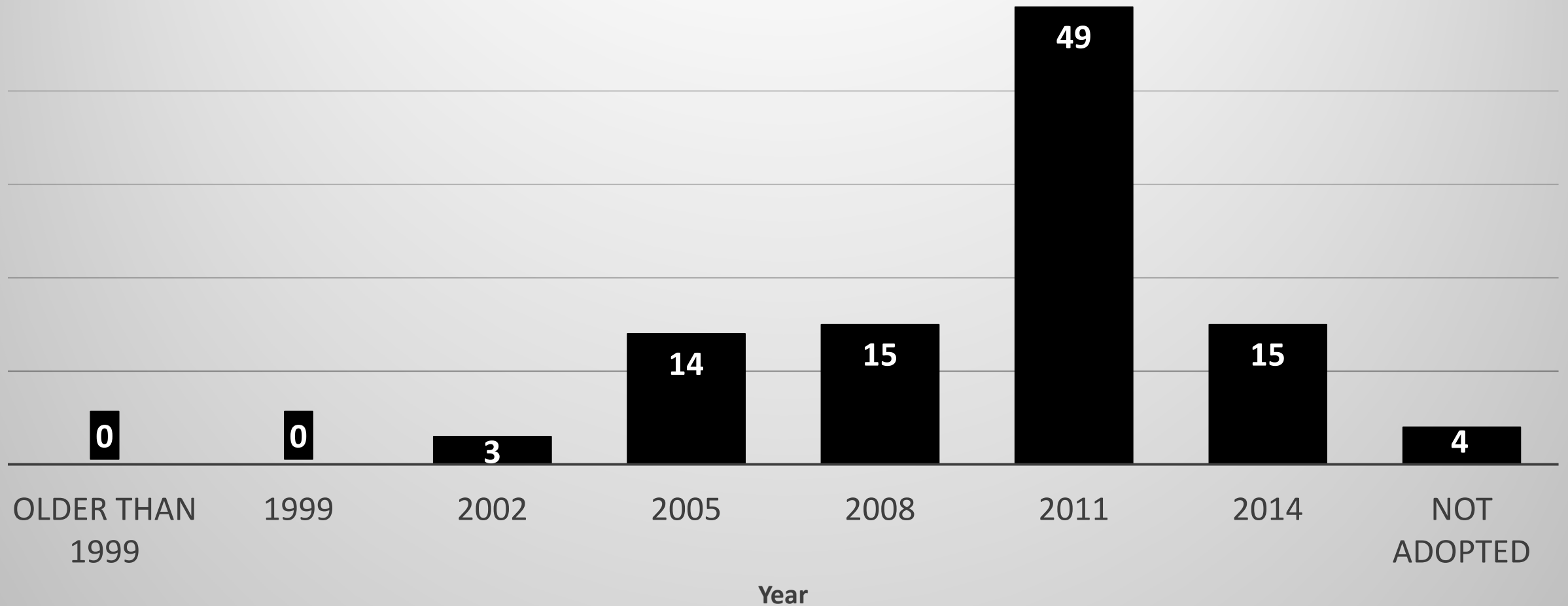


Indicate the year of the code your city has most recently adopted - International Green Construction Code

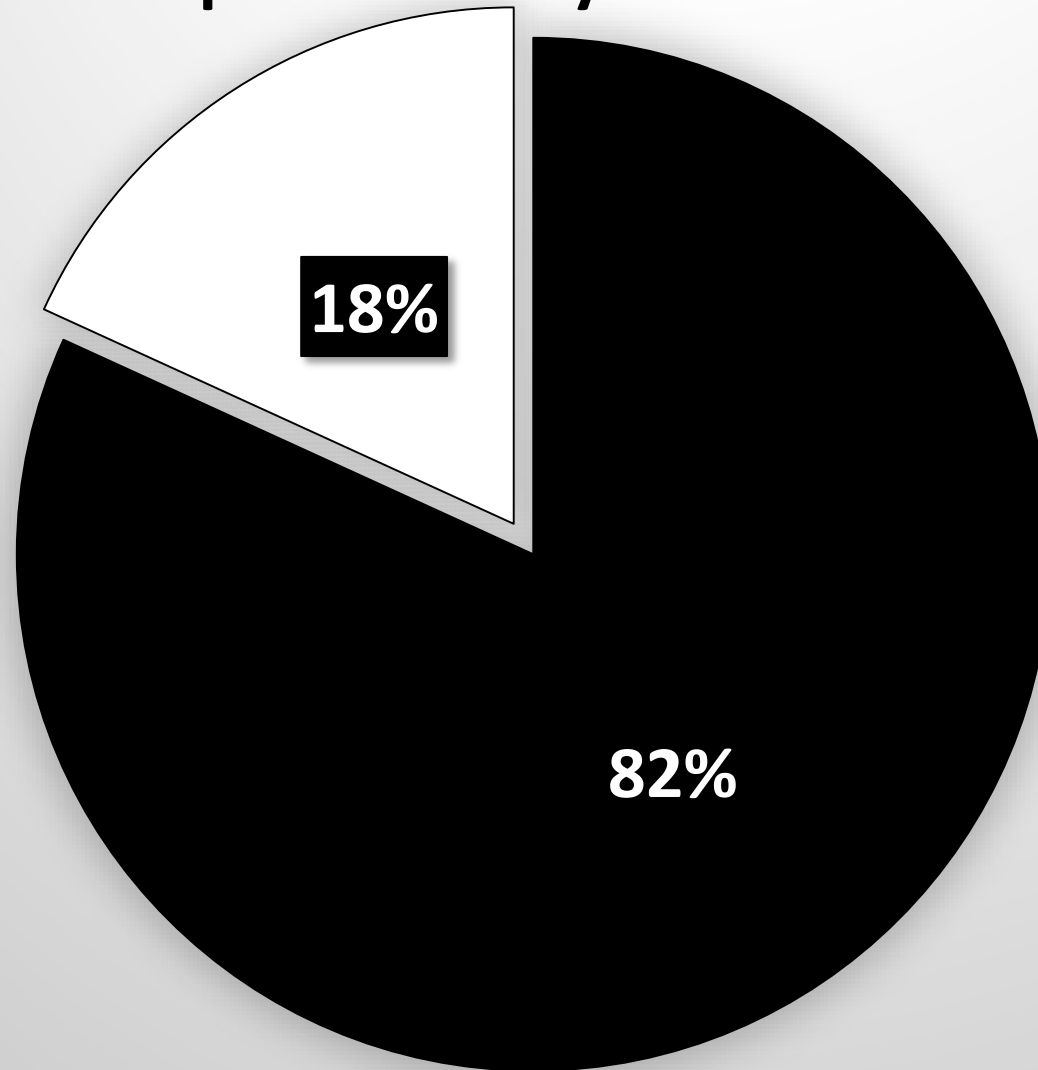
